Summary

This report covers the characteristics of people and households in Silverdale Parish in Newcastle-under-Lyme (GSS code E04008953). Figures are sourced from the 2011 Census key statistics.

There were 4,957 usual residents as at Census day 2011. Of these, 99.4% lived in households and 0.6% lived in communal establishments. The average (mean) age of residents was 40.4 years.

In total there were 2,281 household spaces. Of these, 2,217 (97.2%) had at least one usual resident and 64 (2.8%) had no usual residents.
